Women's Basketball

Annie Sayers — Washington University — Lee's Summit, MO (Lee's Summit North)

Junior Annie Sayers of Washington University scored a career-high 17 points off the bench in a 54-44 win over Webster University on Saturday. The forward hit 8 of 10 from the field, including 5 of 5 for 10 points in the first half. She also pulled down a career-high nine rebounds in the win.

Men's Basketball

Matt Johnson — University of Chicago — Ann Arbor, MI (Pioneer)

University of Chicago guard Matt Johnson averaged 21.7 points, 5.3 rebounds, and 3.3 assists in a 2-1 week for the Maroons. He capped the week with a 37-point performance as Chicago won the Rhodes College Christmas Invitational with an 88-79 victory over the host Lynx in the title game. Johnson tied the school record with eight three-point field goals en route to the title. In an 80-52 win over Berry College on Saturday night, the senior scored 10 points, grabbed six rebounds, and tallied four assists.
